

Stand Up Calendar tutorial



Calendar Supplies

PAPER

Tip Top Taupe, Old Olive, Mint Macaron, Vellum.
Succulent Garden Designer Series Paper

STAMP SET

Oh so Succulent & Love Sparkles

DIES

Succulent Framelits Dies

INKS

Old Olive, Tip Top Taupe, Versamark

EMBELLISHMENTS

Silver embossing powder, Rhinestone, calendar, stand up CD case

ADHESIVES

Adhesive (Tombow etc.), Stampin' Dimensionals

TOOLS

Stampin' Trimmer, Bone Folder, Big Shot, Clear Block

Measurements – Metric

- Tip Top Taupe Cardstock
- Base: 12 cm x 14 cm
- Succulent Garden DSP
- Piece one: 12 cm x 4 cm and piece two: 12 cm x 1.5 cm
- Vellum 12 cm x 4 cm

Measurements – Imperial

- Tip Top Taupe Cardstock
- Base: 4 6/8" x 5 1/2"
- Succulent Garden DSP
- Piece one: 4 6/8" x 1 9/16" and piece two: 4 6/8" x 5/8"
- Vellum 4 6/8" 1 9/16"



Instructions

1. Cut the card stock in Tip Top Taupe to size. Adhere the strips of DSP to the top and bottom of the card as pictured.
2. Using Versamark, stamp the word "sparkle" and emboss in silver using the heat tool. Adhere the vellum over the top of the DSP at the top of the card.
3. Securely adhere the calendar as pictured. I used Tombow glue.
4. Stamp a selection of succulents and vines using the tone on tone technique (Old Olive onto the Old Olive cardstock etc) and cut the pieces out using the corresponding Framelit Dies. The top left hand flowers were cut directly from the DSP. Adhere the succulents and vines around the edges of the card. Add a Rhinestone to the middle of the bottom succulent.
