Supplies

PAPER

Old Olive, Whisper White.
Succulent Garden Designer Series Paper

STAMP SET

Oh So Succulent & Love Sparkles

DIES

Succulent Framelits Dies

INKS

Sweet Sugarplum, Old Olive, Mint Macaron, Black StazOn

PUNCH

Triple Banner Punch

ADHESIVES

Adhesive (Tombow etc.), Stampin' Dimensionals

TOOLS

Stampin' Trimmer, Bone Folder, Big Shot, Clear Block (optional-aquapainter).

Measurements – Metric

Card Base

- Old Olive Cardstock
- Card Base: 10.5 cm x 29.7cm
- Piece for banner: 10.7 x 3.6cm
- Succulent Garden DSP
- Piece one: 9.8 cm x 14.2 cm and piece two: 4.9 cm x 12.8 cm
- White Cardstock
- Piece one 5.2 cm x 13 cm and piece two 3.3 cm x 10.4 cm. Offcut of White cardstock.

Measurements – Imperial

Card Base

- Old Olive Cardstock
- Card Base: 5 ½" x 8 ½"
- Piece for banner: 4 ½" x 1 ⅜"
- Succulent Garden DSP
- Piece One 4" x 5 ⅜" and piece two, 1 ⅞" x 4 ⅞"
- White Cardstock
- Piece One 2"x 5" and piece two, 1 ⅞" x 4 1/8". Offcut of White cardstock.



Instructions

1. Cut the card stock in Old Olive to size, score down centre and fold in middle. Burnish crease using the bone folder.
2. Adhere piece 1 of the Succulent Garden DSP using Tombow or preferred adhesive to the front of the card.
3. Adhere piece 2 of the Succulent Garden DSP to piece 1 of the White Cardstock to create a panel and adhere the panel, offset to the left, to the card using Tombow or preferred adhesive.
4. Using the Triple Banner Punch, punch out a V shaped end for piece two of the White cardstock and the banner piece of Old Olive cardstock (separately).
5. Using the "thank you" or other chosen sentiment from the Love Sparkles stamp set, stamp in the centre of the White card using Black StazOn. Adhere the White cardstock to the Old Olive, keeping a border around the edge. Adhere the combined piece, around one third down from the top of the card.
6. Using StazOn, stamp two each of the smaller succulent stamps and a selection of hanging vines onto an offcut piece of White cardstock and colour in using either the pens or ink with an Aquapainter. Cut each piece out using the corresponding Framelit Die and the Bigshot. Adhere each piece around the edge of the sentiment as pictured, or your preferred layout, using a combination of Stampin' Dimensionals and Tombow to create a layered effect. Enjoy the tutorial.
